Sub: Recognition Certificate for the school under sub-rule(4) of rule 11 of Right to Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2009 for the purpose of Section 18 of Right of Children to free and compulsory Education Act, 2009.


Dear, Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application and subsequent correspondence with the school inspection and after approval from the DLC held on 18/06/2025 in this regard, I convey the grant for provisional recognition to **ADARSHA VIDYALAYA ITAKHULI**, vill-Langkashi, p.c-Makum, Dist-Tinsukia-786170, Assam for class I to Class VIII for a period of three years w.e.f. **18/06/2025 to 18/06/2028**.

The above sanction is subjected to fulfillment of following conditions: -

1. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any obligation to recognize/affiliate beyond class VIII.
2. The School shall abide by the provisions of Right to Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act,2009(Annexure-I) and the Right to Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act,2010(Annexure-II).
3. The School shall admit in Class I, to the extent of % of the strength of that class, Children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion. Provided, further that in case of pre primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.
4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per section 12(2) of the act. To receive such reimbursement school shall provide a separate bank account.
5. The society/School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
6. The school shall not deny admission to child for lack of age proof. If such admission is sought subsequent to the extended provided prescribes for admission on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
7. The school shall ensure:
 - a) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
 - b) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - c) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - d) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under rule 23.
 - e) Inclusion of students with disabilities/special needs as per provision of the act.
 - f) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 21(1) of the act.

Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years.



- g) The teachers perform its duties specified under section 21(1) of the act and
 h) The teacher shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities.
8. The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
 9. The School shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the section 19 of the act.
 10. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given:
 - Area of school campus : 14,400 sqm
 - Total built up area : 460 sqm
 - Area of play ground : 300 sqm
 - No. of classrooms : 12
 - Room for Principal, Admin. Office, Staff room, storeroom : 3
 - Multi Activity Hall, science lab, computer lab, maths lab : 4
 - Separate toilet for boys and girls : 16 nos.
 - Drinking water facility : Yes.
 - Kitchen for cooking mid-day meal : 1
 - Barrier free access : Yes
 - Availability of Teaching Learning Material/Play Sports equipment's/Library : **Attached**
 11. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
 12. The school buildings or other structures or the grounds used only for the purpose of education and skill development.
 13. The school is run by a society registered under the Societies Recognition Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
 14. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the statements of Accounts should be sent to the DEO every year.
 15. The Recognition Code Number allotted to your school is TSK/RTE(Recong)/2025/903 dated...19/06/2025.
 16. The school furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the Director of Education/ District Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Government/ Local Authority as may be issued the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
 17. Renewal of Recognition of Society if any, be ensured.
 18. Other conditions as per Annexure- III enclosed.
